

Acrylic Painting Class Supplies Needed

Item	Qty	Sources	Recommendations
Canvas	2-3	Amazon Michaels Blick	Canvas panels are easier to paint on for beginners. Try not to get any smaller than a 9x12, but no bigger than a 16 x 20. You can try more than one size if you'd like.
<u>Acrylic Paint</u> 2 white (if getting 2 oz. or smaller) 1 black 1 red (crimson or bright/brilliant red – <u>NOT</u> scarlet) 1 yellow (cadmium light or primary yellow) 1 blue (cobalt, bright blue, or pthalo blue) Try to stay away from pastel colors.	6	Michaels (Liquitex Basics 4 oz) Michaels (Artist's Loft) Amazon (Generic Liquitex) Amazon (Arteza) Blick (Blick Studio Acrylic) Blick (Amsterdam)	Acrylic tubes tend to be thicker than acrylic bottles. They work best for mixing paint and saturating canvases. The 12ml/0.4 oz. tube sets such as these are fine, but you may run out of certain colors since the tubes are small. They are a good start, though, and often come with brushes.
<u>Flat and round brushes</u> 1 inch flat brush 1 medium flat or round brush (size 6 or 8) 1 thin flat brush (size 1, 2, or 3) 1 thin round brush (size 1, 2, or 3)	4	Amazon (Nylon Set) Michaels (White Synthetic) Blick (Nylon set)	Golden Taklon/nylon or white synthetic work the best for acrylic. Packs of different sizes are great for learning which size you like working with best.
Wax paper or palette paper pad or plastic paint tray *You only need one	1	One roll wax paper from Dollar Store Palette Pad Paint Tray with Lid	This is for mixing paint on. The wax paper and palette pad are great if you don't like washing your palette. If you get a plastic paint palette, I highly recommend getting one with a lid.
Water cup/container	1	Old containers, tupperware, etc.	Recycle!
Paper Towels or old towel	1	1 small roll or 1 rag	For drying off brushes/ cleaning
Palette Knife or tongue depressors/popsicle craft sticks	1	Amazon (Metal) Amazon (Plastic) Craft sticks at Dollar Tree	For mixing paint. *These are optional.
