Drawing Pencils 2H HB 2B 4B	4	<a href="#">Amazon Pack</a> <a href="#">Michaels Pack</a>	6B and 8B are also great!
Blending Stump/Tortillon	1	<a href="#">Amazon</a> <a href="#">Michaels</a>	#4 or smaller sizes work best, but can get multiples sizes to try them out.
White Eraser and/or Kneaded Eraser	1-2	<a href="#">Amazon</a> (kneaded) <a href="#">Amazon</a> (White) <a href="#">Michaels</a>	White erasers erase the best when drawing. Kneaded erasers are great for shading, but not always necessary.
Pencil Sharpener (handheld)	1	Any pencil sharpener will work	I recommend sharpeners with a built-in container to capture the mess. Here are my favorites: <a href="#">Prismacolor</a> <a href="#">Staedtler</a>
