
College of Lake County Fast-Paced Program for Gifted Students in Grades 6-8 Code of Conduct

Verbal Altercation:

1st Offense

- Student will receive a verbal warning and be dismissed from the rest of the day's class.
- Student's parents will be called to pick up student immediately.

2nd Offense – Dismissal from program

- Student's parents will be called to pick up student immediately.
- Student will not be allowed to return to the program. There will be no refund.
- Bullying or physical altercation (any instance of aggressive, defiant or violent behavior): 1st Offense:
 - Aggressor will be dismissed (expelled) from program immediately. Student's parents will be called to pick up student immediately.
 - Student will not be allowed to return to the program. There will be no refund.

I understand that use of cell phones and other electronic devices is not permitted by students while they are signed in for Fast-Paced. All devices must be silenced, turned off and stored out of sight. A device (cell phone, Chromebook, laptop, tablet, etc.) may only be used for classroom work at the specific direction of the instructor. Once that work is completed the device must be put away.

Following the first verbal warning, a device will be confiscated until the end of the class period. The device will be returned to the student's parent at sign-out.
